A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE

In our 4-hour workshops, participants take part in unique, engaging exchanges that will enrich their understanding of Aboriginal culture, and ultimately improve the way they work with Aboriginal communities.

Our workshop format creates meaningful experiences for participants – it’s not just a dry classroom training session. This is designed for participants to strengthen their capacity to understand the diversity and complexities of Aboriginal communities. Participants are then able to translate this new understanding into practice that achieves positive change within their organisation.

Walan Garay workshops explore a range of topics including:

- Aboriginal cultural systems and frameworks;
- the impacts of dominant culture on Aboriginal communities;
- stereotypes and racism; and
- the contemporary Aboriginal landscape.

Previous participants report:

- a deepened understanding of Aboriginal communities and their structures;
- an increased confidence in working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients and communities;
- an increased capacity to deliver culturally safe, responsive and inclusive services;
- the ability to apply the knowledge gained in our workshops into improved service delivery and program outcomes.
